

A Gospel Gathering: When the Gospel Meets Real Life Women's Event

Mission:

- To provide women with a greater understanding of the gospel for salvation and sanctification and its implications for daily life.
- To teach and warn women of false gospels that are common in our culture ([Gal. 1](#)).
- To provide compelling testimonies of the all-sufficiency of Christ through the power of the gospel.
- To consider how the gospel motivates us to strive for faith and obedience in our personal lives.

Program Elements:

- Saturday event from 8:30 a.m.–3 p.m.
- Intergenerational: Speakers and panel members represented all age groups.
- Box lunch provided.
- All speakers were church members so event budget was low—\$15 ticket cost.
- Worship team led throughout the day.
- Two main speakers (forty-five minutes each).
 - Morning speaker explained what is the gospel and how to identify false gospels.
 - Afternoon speaker addressed how these truths work out in the daily realities of life.
- Each woman choose two breakouts to attend.

Breakout Sessions/Panel Discussions:

- Panel members were coached and trained in advance (three per panel, plus a moderator).
- Panels spoke to specific topics using questions that exalted the gospel:
 - The Gospel in Marriage
 - The Gospel in the Workplace
 - The Gospel in Loss/Grief
 - The Gospel and Athletics/Physical Fitness
 - The Gospel in Parenting

- The Gospel in Singleness
- How to Become a Student of God's Word
