1. Nancy asked, “Is heaven ruling in your heart? Is Christ reigning in your life, in your marriage, in your thoughts, and in your emotions?” How are you spiritually challenged by these questions? What would you like to see God change in your life?
2. What facts did you learn about Lucifer and his fall from heaven? (See Isa. 14:12–17; Ezek. 28:14.)
3. We’re never more like Satan than when we’re proud, when we take glory for ourselves that rightly belongs only to God. How does this statement stir you to conviction?
4. Since the fall of mankind, we’ve been in a battle for worship. In what ways does Satan try to steal worship from God today?
5. The cross is the ultimate evidence that God has won the war with Satan (Col. 2:15; Acts 2:23–24). Discuss modern day examples when Satan appeared to say “checkmate” but the King was victorious through one last move.
6. The point and counterpoint between God and Satan will not continue forever. In the final battle, the Lamb will overcome all of His enemies (Rev. 17:14; 19:11–16, 19–21). How does knowing that Satan will be crushed once and for all inspire you to greater hope and peace?
7. While we wait for Christ’s return, we are to bow the knee in total allegiance and worship. What lifestyle changes do you need to make in order to be a true worshiper of the Lamb?
8. Pray together as a group for God to draw you to the sweet place of surrender and fresh love for Christ. Ask for His strength not to give in to fear or discouragement and to walk in the victory Christ accomplished through His life, death, resurrection, and eternal work in heaven.
